Questions - General

- 1) How many players from one team are allowed on the field at any one time?
- 2) Name 3 countries that will be competing in the competition.
- 3) Name 2 modifications to the FIFA general rules of football.

- 4) How long has Jordan been playing Football 7-a-side?
- 5) What position does Jordan play?
- 6) Who is Jordan Raynes' famous relative?

Questions – Richard Fox

- 7) What position does Richard play?
- 8) How many goals did Richard score in the qualifying match against Ireland?
- 9) What is Richard's occupation?
